Note: When we say “*Person*” we mean that the Holy Spirit has the **attributes of a person**, that is, He understands, teaches, guide, gives orders, can be grieved, says, hears, takes, glorifies, etc., and not as some understand about a “*person*” that he is flesh and blood. It is important to keep this in your mind as you answer the questions.

Genesis 1:1-2

“In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters.”

1. Question:

Do you believe, that here **the Spirit is the Holy Spirit** that we read about Him in the Holy Bible and **not** and *active force* as some falsely try to show?
